Project Partners served Fort Worth Academy as the Project Coordinator for Development, managing five key community relations and development initiatives, partnering with the wonderful staff and volunteer teams. The initiatives included the school year kickoff event that raised school spirit and almost \$20,000 for technology programs, the annual giving campaign that provided \$140,000 for the operating budget, the Touch-a-Truck community outreach event, Grandparents Day, a community relations and cultivation tradition, and the annual dinner and auction that creates and cultivates relationships and significant operating dollars of more than \$190,000. Fort Worth Academy, founded in 1982, is a vibrant, co-educational, private, independent K-8 day school located in Southwest Fort Worth.

In the academic year 2016-17, during a key advancement staff transition and the last year before Bill Broderick's retirement, the Academy returned to us for similar management of mission-critical development initiatives.


