


FUNDRAISING CONSULTING '23 Justin's Place

Justin's Place has been working to help families led by single mothers break the cycle of generational poverty since 2016. Organizational leadership launched a capital campaign several years ago to build *The Nest*, a supportive transitional housing community that will add 24 units of deeply affordable housing to Fort Worth. However, fundraising efforts were stalled by the pandemic. In an effort to reinvigorate the campaign, Justin's Place engaged Project Partners to provide guidance and expand fundraising capacity, using a ToolBox Grant from the North Texas Community Foundation.

During our two-month engagement, Project Partners produced a 12-month fundraising plan, assisted with crafting proposals for both government and private foundation funds, and drafted dynamic verbiage related to the capital project that can be used in a variety of funding applications in the future, equipping the team with the tools needed to successfully meet their goals.
