(now One Safe Place) Project Partners originally stepped in for an absent staff member eight weeks out to coordinate the *Imagine No Violence* Art Contest Awards Event with Safe City and the Fort Worth ISD. For seven years, we continued to manage this annual community project that helped create a Safe City - including the collaborative team, collateral materials, logistics, décor, production and show flow, the communications, vendor management and the budget and administration. This event aptly treated more than 750 Fort Worth and Arlington ISD elementary, middle and high school winners and their families with an art viewing reception, great refreshments, entertainment, décor, prizes, celebrities, and community leaders lauding their accomplishments at venues such as The Ballpark in Arlington, the Fort Worth Zoo, and the Round-up Inn.

Project Partners applied the same comprehensive project direction services to the 2009 Safe City Ball and the 2010 Safe City Ball-Game. The Safe City Ball at the Omni Hotel featured Randy Travis and attracted more than \$500,000 of community support. The Safe City Ball-Game was in cooperation with the Texas Rangers, and featured Clint Black in concert.

In 2020, One Safe Place once again called on Project Partners for expert grant writing assistance when they joined forces with Shaken Baby Alliance to apply for the Department of Health & Human Services (HHS) Family Violence Prevention and Services Act grant.
