In 2022, Project Partners worked with the Rainwater Charitable Foundation (RCF) to develop and implement two leadership awards programs to celebrate the Foundation's 30th anniversary: a national "Tau Leadership Fellows" program and a Fort Worth "High School Scholars" college scholarship program. Through these one-time, banner year programs, RCF distributed \$600,000 in awards and scholarships to 60 current and future leaders. Project Partners collaborated with RCF staff to create the award and scholarship applications, identify potential applicants and referral sources, and manage the application review and selection process. Project Partners created and implemented the marketing and outreach plan, including design and distribution of promotional materials and PR, communications with referral sources and applicants, and recognition of award and scholarship recipients.

In 2023, facilitated an all-staff retreat focused on organizational values.
